Catalog of the slaves belonging to Hatman Constantin Paladi from the town of Ciorăști (Vrancea county) 1833-1834

The catalog covers four pages. 35 villages with 153 souls (72 male, 81 female) are registered.

Most of the heads of the family dealt with the fiddle: fiddler (6), fiddler (6), carpenter (1), cobbler (8), blacksmith (6), cook (1), butcher (2). The occupation is not recorded for two family heads, in three other families they are deceased.

Analyzing the age of those registered in the register, we can see an increased mortality, doubled by a high birth rate: category 1-10 years (54 people), category 11-20 years (32 people), category 21-30 years (23 people), category 31 -40 years old (28 people), 41-50 years old category (6 people), 51-60 years old category (five people), 61-70 years old category (three people), 71-80 years old category (one person).

In terms of family size, most of them had between 1 and 2 children: no children (eight families), between 1-2 children (13 families), between 3-4 children (nine families), over five children (five families). Regarding the marital status, 27 couples were religiously married, in five others the husband was deceased (to these are added three unmarried male persons). In the vast majority of couples, the age difference between spouses varies between one and ten years: between 1-5 years (12 couples), between 6-10 years (12 couples), between 11-15 years (three couples), over 15 years (a couple).
